

Techmagri System practised by Mr Richard Cross on medium and heavy clay soil near Bury St Edmunds, Suffolk



Stubbles are loosened with the Techmagri Profilab when soil moisture is sufficient to deter the creation of clods.



OSR is sown with the Profilab, fitted with a Stocks Micro Meter. Fields are then rolled or pressed and rolled, as required.



Fields for cereals are pressed, leaving an ideal surface for drilling.



Cereals are sown with the Techmagri Techmasem L 4.8m drill.



Stubbles for Spring Beans and Sugar Beet are Profilabed in September. Sugar Beet is sown using a drill with mulch sowing attachment (inset).



Spring Beans are drilled direct into either ploughed or Profilabed ground using the Techmasem L.
